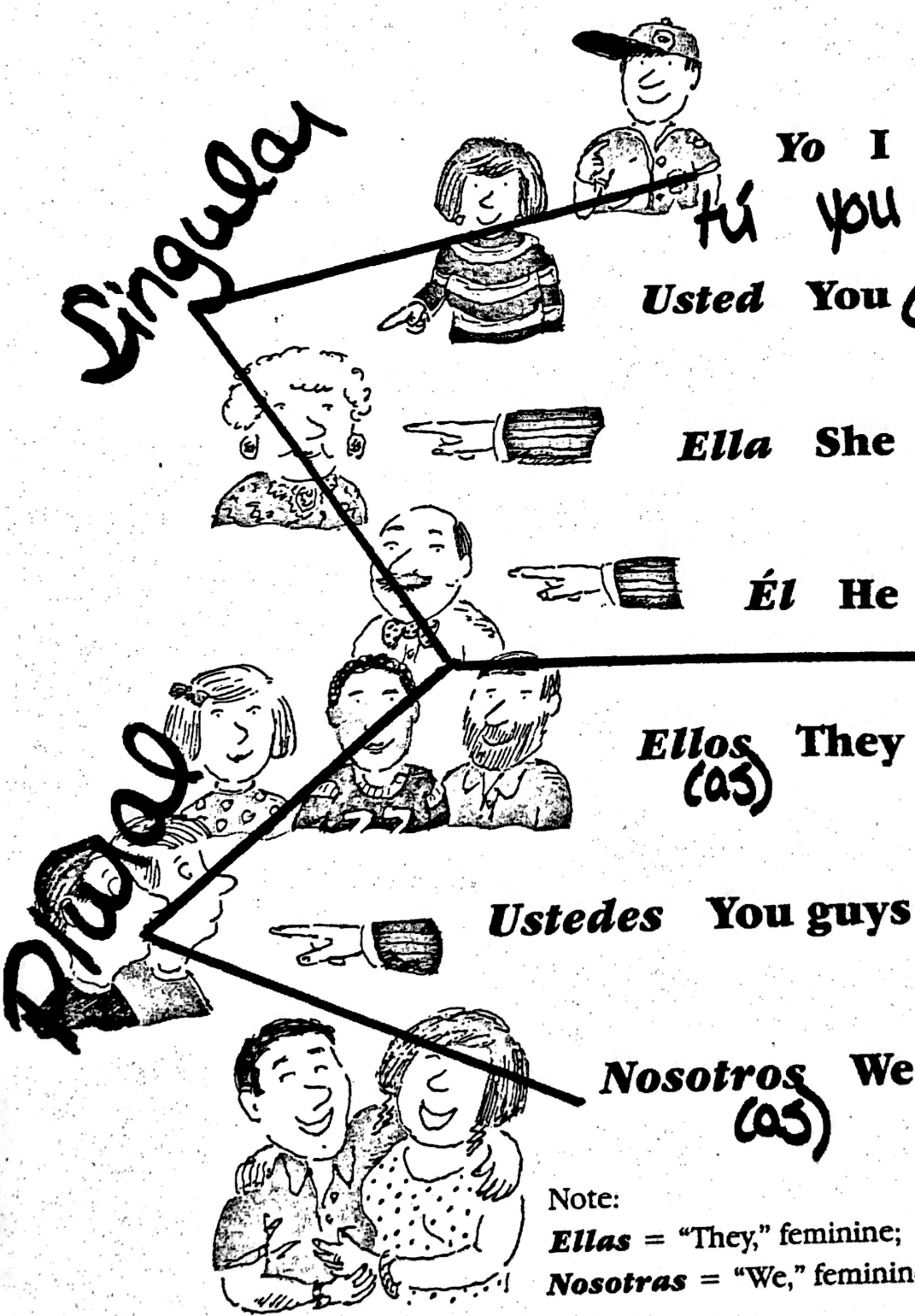


Who's Who?

To really get going, you've got to know these important words, which can designate the "who" of a *quién(es)* question.

Use these words as you do their English equivalents and don't forget to point.



HOT TIPS!

- The preceding *quién* words (subject pronouns) work wonderfully as one-word responses. Notice how they also "start you off" when expressing a complete message:
¿Quién es inteligente? — Ella es inteligente. (Who is intelligent? — She is intelligent.)
- *Él, ella, ellos, and ellas* can refer to things as well as as people: *Los libros, ¿dónde están ellos?* (The books, where are they?)
- "Grab onto" the first word in all questions, because they will make answering so much easier!

Note:
Ellas = "They," feminine;
Nosotras = "We," feminine.
